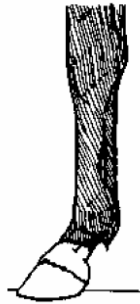

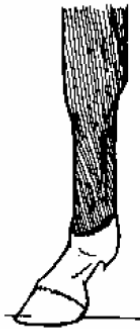

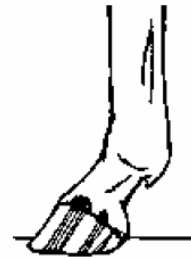

Face Markings

Star - found high up between the eyes - often a diamond shape



Snip - small mark on the muzzle



Blaze - broad marking down the front of the horse's face



Stripe - long straight marking down the horse's nose



Bald Face - marking that covers most of the horse's face.



Star, Stripe & Snip - marking which extends all the way down to the horse's muzzle.



Other Markings

- Brand:** A design burned into the skin to identify an animal.
- Freeze Brand:** A brand made by freezing instead of heat. The hair grows in white. Usually letters or numbers are used.
- Scar:** A permanent mark left by an injury that has healed.
